SHOW CLASSES:

Baby Class – dogs from 4 to 6 months.

Puppy Class – dogs from 6 to 9 months.

Junior Class – dogs from 9 to 18 months.

Intermediate Class – dogs from 15 to 24 months.

Open Class – dogs over 15 months.

Working Class – dogs over 15 months. Entry requires a certificate of working trial results. The Working Certificate must be submitted together with the entry form.

Champion Class – dogs over 15 months. Entry requires the certificate verifying the champion title. The certificate must be submitted together with the entry form.

Veteran Class – dogs over 8 years.

Breeder`s Class – 3 to 5 dogs of the same breed from one breeder. Dogs must come from at least two different combinations of stud male and bitch and be over 9 months of age. All the dogs in the class must have received at least „very good“ on the given show in quality judging.

Progeny Class – 3 to 5 offsprings of stud male or female. The offspring must come from at least two different combinations of stud male and bitch and be over 9 months of age and must have received at least „very good“ on the given show in quality judging.

Brace – Male and female dog of same breed owned by same person and handled by one handler. Both dogs must be at least 9 months of age and receive at least „very good“ on the given show.
